

CONTRACT FOR MUSICAL PERFORMANCE

The following is a contract between a Firedog (Band) and an individual or organization (Client) that wants to hire band to provide entertainment.

Client is _____, of _____

Band will perform music in an interactive show that will provide lively entertainment for everyone. Band set lists and a demo CD have been provided as part of the promotion material provided to Client. Band contact information is included in the tech/rider attached to this contract and incorporated into the contract by reference:

1. Band agrees to perform high energy blues, R&B and original material for _____ hours for Client on _____ at the location _____, _____ . Band shall play _____ sets of approximately 45 minutes each with a 15-minute break between sets. Band shall commence playing at approximately _____ .m., and conclude playing at approximately _____ .m.
2. Client shall pay Band \$ _____ for the performance. A deposit of \$ _____ shall be paid on the date of signing of this contract, with full payment of the balance due paid in cash or check prior to the beginning of the performance. Checks shall be made payable to "Firedog".
3. Client shall provide Band access to the area where the performance is to occur (the stage area) no later than _____ on the day of the performance so that Band can set up and complete a sound check. Client understands that Band will play at full volume during this sound check.
4. Band retains the right at its sole discretion to modify personnel for any performance.
5. Client shall provide Band with a stage area sufficient to allow Band to set up its equipment as per the stage set-up diagram attached to the tech/rider. Client shall provide reasonable parking for Band vehicles and reasonable access to the stage area to allow for equipment to be brought in, set up, and broken down after the performance and removed back to Band vehicles. Client shall take reasonable steps to prevent the public (non-Band persons) from going upon the stage and backstage area and handling Band equipment.
6. Client shall provide reasonable and safe space to store guitar cases, piano cases, equipment bags, storage chests, amp covers and other personal items of the band. Client shall also provide male and female toilet facilities and a private space to change to and from stage clothing. Client shall provide soft drinks, water and coffee to band upon request.

7. Band shall be excused from performing if due to sudden illness of key personnel (where reasonable efforts to find a substitution are unsuccessful) or bad weather that makes it impractical for Band to get to the performance. Client shall be excused from payment if, due to bad weather, the venue for the performance cannot operate, forfeiting deposit.

8. Client shall provide sufficient number of working and properly-grounded electrical outlets to provide power to the band, with sufficient amperage. See tech/rider.
